The conference is expected to feature up to twenty 75-minute sessions, organized into thematic tracks. Sessions may feature a single speaker or two to three speakers and a moderator. All sessions should allow time for audience participation/Q&A. Proposals will be accepted in the following categories:

- •Built Environment: Sessions and speakers that highlight buildings, neighborhoods, and structures and the advocacy, innovations and stories that contribute to their community value, preservation and/or adaptive reuse
- •Heritage Resource Management: Projects, initiatives and programs that help communities care for, learn from, interpret and manage their local and regional heritage.
- •Community and Regional Initiatives: Programs and initiatives focused on building grassroots support and thoughtful planning, and the integration of heritage into community and regional cohesion and vision.
- •Other: An opportunity to share stories, ideas, and lessons that do not easily conform to one of the established categories or that span category boundaries. Is your idea a little outside the box? No problem! Please submit a proposal or get in touch with us and talk about how it might work for this conference.
